The Director of Rehabilitation, Madras is informed that licence fees
in question are collected under the powers vested in the Municipal
Councils by section 321(2) of the Tamil Nadu District Municipalities Act,
1920 and this section does not provide for any exemption being granted
from payment of licence fee. The Government will however have no
objection to the collection of the licence fees being waived, if the
concerned Municipal Council agrees to waive such fees.
