**Draft Amendment to Tamil Nadu Standards of Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Rules, 1989.**

[G.O. Ms. No. 100, Labour and Employment, (G1) 28th July 2009.]

No. SRO A-24/2009.—The following draft of an amendment to the Tamil Nadu Standards of Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Rules, 1989, which the State Government proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 72 of the Standards of Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Act, 1985 (Central Act 54 of 1985), is hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby. Notice is hereby given that the said draft amendment will be taken into consideration on or before the expiry of a period of six weeks from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* as required under sub-section (4) of Section 72 of the said Act. Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person with respect thereto, before the aforesaid period of six weeks will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu. ## DRAFT AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 20, in sub-rule (1) for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(a) is a graduate of a recognised University in Science (with physics as one of the subject), technology or engineering, or holds a recognised diploma in engineering with three years professional experience; and”.
