APPOINTMENT OF DATES FOR VARIOUS STAGES AND FIXATION OF HOURS OF POLL FOR BIENNIAL ELECTIONS TO COUNCIL OF STATES TO FILL VACANCIES OF MEMBERS RETIRING DURING JUNE, 2010.

The following Notification of the Election Commission of India, New Delhi, dated 31st May, 2010 [Jyaistha 10, 1932 (Saka)] is republished:—

No. 318/2/2010 (1).—Whereas, the President of India has, by notification issued under Section 12 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951) and published in the Gazette of India on 31st May, 2010, been pleased to call upon the elected members of each of the Legislative Assemblies of the States, specified in column (1) of the TABLE below, to elect to the Council of States, the number of members specified against that State in column (2) of the said TABLE:—

Now, therefore, in pursuance of sub-section (1) of Section 39 and Section 56 of the said Act, the Election Commission of India hereby—

(A) Appoints, with respect to the said election:

- (a) the 7th June, 2010 (Monday), as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) the 8th June, 2010 (Tuesday), as the date for the scrutiny of the nominations;
- (c) the 10th June, 2010 (Thursday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures;
- (d) the 17th June, 2010 (Thursday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken; and
- (e) the 19th June, 2010 (Saturday), as the date before which the election shall be completed; and

(B) Fixes the hours from 9.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M. as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken in all the above mentioned States, on the date specified above for the election.

The following Notification of the Election Commission of India, New Delhi, dated 31st May, 2010 [Jyaistha 10, 1932 (Saka)] is republished:—

No.318/2/2010 (2):—In pursuance of Section 21, and in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 22 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission of India, in consultation with the Government of each States, specified in column (1) of the TABLE below, hereby—

(i) designates the officer, specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) of the said TABLE, to be the Returning Officer; and

(ii) appoints the officer, specified in the corresponding entry in column (3) of the said Table, to be the Assistant Returning Officer to assist the Returning Officer in the performance of his functions;
