Whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of the Article 258 of the Constitution of India, the President of India, has, in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Co-operation (Department of Agriculture) Notification No.4(1)/65, General-II, dated 23rd April 1966, entrusted to the Government of Tamil Nadu with their consent, the functions of the Central Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Central Act I of 1894), in relation to Acquisition of Lands for the purpose of the Union in this State.

And, whereas it has already been decided that the compensation should be paid from the public revenues.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the said Act, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares the land specified in the schedule below and measuring 00918 sq.mt. be the same, a little more or less, is needed for a public purpose, to wit for the extension of Railway Yard at Tenkasi Railway Station in Tirunelveli District.

A plan of the lands are kept in the Office of the Revenue Divisional Officer, Tenkasi and may be inspected at any time during office hours.
