ACQUISITION OF LANDS

Whereas in exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (1) of Article 258 of the Constitution of India, the President has entrusted to the Government of Tamil Nadu in Letter No. 4(1)/65 Central II Food, Agriculture Community Development and Co-operation (Agriculture), dated 23rd April 1966, with their consent the functions of the Central Government under the land acquisition Act, 1894 (Central Act I of 1894) in relation to acquisition of land for the purposes of the union in this state and whereas it has already been decided that the compensation should be paid by the public revenues.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the said Act, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares that the lands specified in the schedule below and measuring 2.04.0 hectares, be the same a little more or less, is needed for a public purpose, to wit, for the formation of new Broad Gauge Railway Line between Tindivanam and Tiruvannamalai at So. Kzhilnachipattu Village of Tiruvannamalai Taluk of Tiruvannamalai District and under Sections 3 and 7 of the same Act the Revenue Divisional Officer, Tiruvannamalai is appointed to perform the functions of a collector under the Act, and directed to take order for the acquisition of the said lands.

Under sub-section(1) and (2) of Section 17 of the Act, the Governor of Tamil Nadu further directs that the possession of the said lands may be taken immediately after the publication of the notice mentioned in Section 9 (1) of the Act. A plan of the land is kept in the office of the Revenue Divisional Officer, Tiruvannamalai and may be inspected at any time during office hours.
