Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Highways Engineering Service.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Highways Engineering Service (Section 17 of Part III A in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1969):—

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 20th September 1984.

AMENDMENTS

- (1) rule 5 shall be omitted;
- (2) rule 6 shall be omitted;
- (3) rule 7 shall be omitted;
- (4) in rule 10;—

- (a) in the marginal heading for the expression "Qualification for Assistant Divisional Engineers and Assistant Engineers" the marginal heading "Qualifications" shall be substituted;
- (b) in THE TABLE, above the entry "Assistant Divisional Engineer" in column (1) and the corresponding entries relating thereto in columns (2) and (3) the following entries shall respectively, be inserted, namely:—

"Superintending Engineer

Promotion

Must possess B.E. degree in Civil or Mechanical Engineering or a pass in Sections - A and B of the A.M.I.E., (India) Examinations (re-named as Institution Examination).

Divisional Engineer including
Deputy Chief Engineer

Promotion

Must have put in service for a period of not less than five years as Assistant Divisional Engineer";

- (5) rule 11 shall be omitted.
