HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE DEPARTMENT

Amendments to the Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Medical Service.

No. SRO B-31/2013.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Medical Service (Section 21 in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1969).

2. The Amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 11th January 2008.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules, in Part II, in Branch-I Medical—

(1) for the categories "Non-Clinical Readers", "Non-Clinical Tutors or Assistants", "Clinical Readers" and "Clinical Tutors or Assistants" wherever they occur, the following categories shall, respectively be substituted, namely:-

"Non-Clinical Associate Professors", "Tutors / Assistant Professors", "Clinical Associate Professors" and "Senior Residents / Assistant Professors";

(2) in rule 1, under 'CLASS I', after the expression "Category 20 - Civil Surgeon Specialists", the following expression shall be added, namely--

"Category 21- Professor";

(3) in rule 2, in sub- rule (a), under the heading "Civil Surgeon's Cadre" in Column (1), after the expression "Category 20 - Civil Surgeon Specialists", the following expression shall be added, namely:-

"Category 21 - Professor";

(4) in rule 3, in sub-rule (a), under the heading 'CLASS I', after the expression "Category 20 - Civil Surgeon Specialists" in the first column and the entries relating thereto in the second column, the following expression and entries shall, respectively be added, namely:-

"Category 21- Professor:

By Promotion from among the holders of the post of Associate Professors";

(5) in the Annexure [referred to in rule (8c)], -

(i) for Notes (a), (b), (c) and (d) after "Class-I, Category 10", the following Notes shall be substituted, namely:-

(a) No person shall be appointed to the post of Associate Professor in any subject, either Clinical or Non - Clinical unless he possesses teaching experience for a period of not less than five years as Assistant Professor in the speciality concerned.

(b) No person shall be appointed to the post of Associate Professor in the Super speciality unless he possesses teaching experience for a period of not less than two years as Assistant Professor in the speciality concerned";

(ii) After Notes (a) and (b) as so substituted, Notes "(e)" and "(f)" shall be re- lettered as "(c)" and "(d)" respectively;

(iii) in Note (c) as so re-lettered,

(a) For the expression "clauses (a) to (d) above", the expression "this Annexure" shall be substituted;

(b) For the expression "University of Madras", the expression "Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical Univesity" shall be substituted;

(iv) in Note (d) as so re-lettered, for the expression "clauses (a) to (e) above", the expression "this Annexure" shall be substituted;

(v) under "Class I, Category 11",-

(a) For the entry "Senior Residents / Assistant Professors" as so substituted in column (1) and the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively be substituted, namely:-

"Senior Resident or Assistant Professor	Must have obtained the degree of MBBS of any University or Institutions recognized by the University Grant's Commission and must have done Post Graduate work in a teaching institution for a period of not less than two years or must possess a super speciality degree";

(b) The following Notes shall be added, namely:-

Note—

(a) Any person working as Tutor or Senior Resident shall be redesignated as Assistant Professor in their respective speciality from the date of passing of three years Post graduate degree in that speciality.

(b) If the Post graduate degree in the concerned speciality is of two year period, then redesignation as Assistant Professor shall be done only after serving as Tutor or Senior Resident for a period of one year in that speciality after acquiring the post graduate qualification:

Provided that-those who possess a two year diploma in the speciality concerned in addition to the post graduate degree shall be redesignated as Assistant Professor from the date of passing of the post graduate degree.

(c) Any person having a super speciality degree, on completion of one year service as Senior Resident, shall be redesignated as Assistant Professor in the Super speciality.";

(vi) after the entry "Class-I, Category 20 - Civil Surgeon Specialists" in column (1) and the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively be inserted, namely:-

"Class I, Category 21-

Professor	Must Possess teaching experience for a period of not less than four years as Associate Professor in any subject or in a super speciality either on clinical or non-clinical side".

Adhoc Rules relating to the Temporary Posts of State Statistical Training Institute in Tamil Nadu Statistics Services.

No. SRO B-33/2013.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following rules:-

2. The Rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 24th February 2012.

RULES

The General and the Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in the Tamil Nadu Statistics Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary posts of Director, Reader in Official Statistics and Lecturer in Official Statistics, State Statistical Training Institute, subject to the modifications specified in the following rules:-

2. *CONSTITUTION*:- These posts shall constitute a separate category in a distinct class of the said service.

3. *APPOINTMENT*:- Appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the table below, shall be made by the methods specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof.

“Provided that notwithstanding anything contained in clause (14) of rule 2 in Part-I, Preliminary of the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules, regular members in any of the Services of the Government of Tamil Nadu shall also be eligible for appointment to the posts of Director, Reader in Official Statistics and Lecturer in Official Statistics by direct recruitment”.

4. *PROMOTION*:- Promotion to the post of Director shall be made on grounds of merit and ability, seniority being considered only where merit and ability are approximately equal.

5. *QUALIFICATIONS*:- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the table below, by the method specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof.

6. *APPOINTING AUTHORITY* - (i) The appointing authority for the post of Director and Reader in Official Statistics shall be the Government.

(ii) The appointing authority for the post of Lecturer in Official Statistics shall be the Director of the Department of Economics and Statistics.

7. *PROBATION*:- (i) Every person appointed to any category by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty be on probation for a total period of two years on duty with in a continuous period of three years.

(ii) Every person appointed to any category by recruitment by transfer shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of one year on duty with in a continuous period of two years.

8. *PREPARATION OF THE ANNUAL LIST OF APPROVED CANDIDATES*:- For the Purpose of drawing up the annual list of approved candidates for appointment to the posts in the service by recruitment by transfer, by promotion and by transfer the crucial date on which the candidate should be qualified shall be the 1st September of every year.

9. *PAY*:- There shall be paid to the holders of the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below, a monthly pay calculated in the pay band with grade pay specified in the corresponding entries in Column (2) and (3) thereof,
