Sub: Travelling Allowance - Daily Allowance for halts outside the state - certain clarification. Ref: G.O.Ms.No.93 Finance (All-I) dated:8-2-1983.

In the Government order cited, the Government have issued orders enhancing the rates of Daily Allowance for stay in hotels, Guest Houses of Government and Public Sector and Joint Sector undertakings and by making Private arrangements, at Delhi, Bombay, Calcutta and other State headquarters. A point has been raised for clarification as to how the rate of Daily Allowance for stay in guest rooms maintained by Associations or clubs, has to be regulated.

- 2. Stay in a club cannot be considered as by Private arrangement, as only stay with a friend or a relative (non-institutional) can be considered as by private arrangement. Stay in a club or Association which provides lodging accommodation can, however, be equated with stay in hotels.
- 3. In the light of the position stated above, the claim of daily allowance for stay in rooms provided by registered clubs or Associations like Y.M.C.A., Y.W.C.A., Y.M.I.A., Cosmopolitan club etc., or Tourist Development Corporations, should be regulated as per the rates applicable for stay in hotels, subject to the production of wouchers of the Associations or clubs concerned, as mentioned in para 3 of the Government order referred to above.
