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ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above Kangeyam Town Panchayat was classified as second grade Municipality.

2) In the Government Order second read above 36 third grade Municipalities were classified as various grades of Municipalities.

3) In the Government Order third read above Oddanchatram Town Panchayat was classified as second grade Municipality.

4) In the Government Order fourth read above Melvisharam third grade Municipality was classified as second grade Municipality.

5) The Commissioner of Municipal Administration in his letter seventh read above has stated that a proposal to fix the staff norms for all the municipalities as per norms committee recommendation was sent to Government in their letter Roc.No.43141/2007/OP1, dated:11.09.2008. The above said norms committee recommendation is under examination of the Government. It will need some more time to issue orders on the recommendation of the norms committee.

6) The Commissioner of Municipal Administration in his letter seventh read above has sent a proposal for creation of 144 posts in 31 upgraded Municipalities. Finally, The Commissioner of Municipal Administration in his letter eighth read above has requested to sanction of 124 posts in 27 upgraded Municipalities [Listed out in Annexure-I & II] adducing the following reasons in support of his proposal:

- (i) The 227 posts created in the Government Order fifth read above are not sufficient to deliver the mandatory services to be rendered by the Municipalities.
- (ii) Though the erstwhile Town Panchayats which were re-classified as Third Grade Municipalities were subsequently upgraded to various grades of Municipalities depending upon their annual income, the total strength of staff remains the same and the day to day services to be provided by the Municipality are severely affected.
- (iii) In the municipalities which were upgraded from Town Panchayats, it is essential to have the posts like Manager (Grade IV), Engineer Grade-3 (A.E/J.E cadre) Work Inspector, Revenue Inspector and Town Planning Inspector.
- (iv) The posts that are requested to be created are barest minimum and compared to the posts as per 'Norms' it is very meager in terms of numbers. As per Norms there will be 22 categories in General Service, 23 categories in Engineering Service, 5 categories in Public Health Service, 10 categories in Public Health (non-centralised) Service, 5 categories in Town Planning Service and 11 categories in Medical Service whereas, posts under 2 categories in General Service, posts under only one category each in Town Planning and Engineering Service (that too only one post in each category) for 11 Municipalities and in addition to the above 1 Municipal Engineer Post for 16 Municipalities are requested.
- (v) The posts now requested, fall far short of the norms to be prescribed and the salary and pension commitment, after the creation will not exceed the 49% cap and the expenditure is to be borne from the Municipal General Funds only.

7) The Government have examined the proposal of Commissioner of Municipal Administration, carefully in the light of the reasons adduced by him and decided to accept the same. Accordingly, Government accord approval for creation of 124 new posts as mentioned in the Annexures to this order, in the category of Manager Grade-IV, Work Inspector, Revenue Inspector and Town Planning Inspector

in 11 Municipalities (Annexure-I to this order) and Manager Class IV, Work Inspector Revenue Inspector and Town Planning Inspector and Engineer Grade III (in the cadre of A.E./J.E.) in 16 Municipalities. (Annexure-II to this order), subject to the condition that the staff cost will not exceed the 49% cap and expenditure to be borne by the concerned Municipal General Funds.


