ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced in the function held on 29.12.2007 in connection with the upgradation of Tiruppur Municipality as Corporation, that regarding the formation of Tiruppur district, a report will be obtained from the Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Revenue Administration and that an announcement will be made in the Assembly. In the Budget speech of the Hon'ble Finance Minister for the year 2008-2009, it has been announced that a new district with Tiruppur as its headquarters will be carved out of Coimbatore and Erode districts and that formation of a new district will bring the Administration closer to the people.

2. Based on the above announcement, the Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Revenue Administration has visited Coimbatore and Erode Districts on 22.7.2008 & 23.7.2008 and heard the views and received the representations of elected members, leaders of political parties, organizations and various sections of the people and after analyzing the same with reference to the reports of the Districts Collectors of Coimbatore and Erode Districts, he has sent a detailed feasibility report to the Government.

3. The Government have examined the report of the Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Revenue Administration in detail and pass the following orders:-

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- i) The Coimbatore and Erode districts be reorganised into Coimbatore, Erode and Tiruppur Districts as follows:-
 - a) Coimbatore District with Head Quarters at Coimbatore.
 - b) Erode District with Head Quarters at Erode.
 - c) Tiruppur District with Head Quarters at Tiruppur.

(ii) The Jurisdiction of the Coimbatore, Erode and Tiruppur Districts is indicated in the Annexure -I to this order.

4. Sanction is accorded for the creation of one post of Special Officer in the senior scale of I.A.S., with supporting staff as indicated in the Annexure-II to this order for a period of six months from the date of appointment or till the necessity for it ceases, whichever is earlier, to work out the details of the reorganisation.

(ii) The Special Officer will take charge of the administration of the new District immediately. The incumbents of these posts will be eligible to draw, besides pay, the other allowances admissible under the orders in force.

(iii) The Special Officer will take into account the staff sanctioned in the Annexure-II to this order, while submitting proposals to Government through Principal Secretary & Commissioner of Revenue Administration for sanction of staff in accordance with the staff pattern for a District.

(iv) Till a new building is constructed for Tiruppur District, sanction is granted to fix the rent for accommodation of the office of the Special Officer as per the PWD rules and as per G.O(Ms)No. 329 Finance (Salaries) dated. 30.8.2001.

(v) The Special Officer, Tiruppur District will immediately attend to all the works such as location of buildings for the revenue offices, separation of records etc, relating to his District and all such works which are incidental consequent on the formation of the new District and Taluk .

5. Sanction is accorded for incurring expenditure for an approximate amount of Rs.10 lakhs (Rupees Ten Lakhs) for the purchase of 2 (Two) New Ambassador Cars of which, one is for the official use of the Special Officer of new Tiruppur District and the other one is for the use of the V.I.Ps visiting the new Tiruppur District. Sanction is also accorded for provision of Telephone at a recurring expenditure of Rs. 18,000/- per annum and non recurring expenditure of Rs.3,000/- towards deposit.

6. The Collectors of Coimbatore and Erode Districts and the Special Officer of Tiruppur District are requested to take immediate action to give effect to the

decisions of the Government in the order and send necessary proposals including the proposals for the formation of new Sulur Taluk through Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration.

7. The Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorised to draw the amount sanctioned in para 5 above and make payment in advance to the suppliers. The Collector of Coimbatore is authorised to sanction the payment of charges towards fuel, telephone etc incurred by the Special Officer. The Government also permit the District Treasury Officer, Coimbatore to admit the claims of the Collector of Coimbatore pertaining to expenditure relating to the new District.

8. The expenditure on the staff should be debited to " 2053.00. District Administration -093. District Establishments -I Non - Plan - AA Collectors and Magistrates-01 Salaries" (D.P..Code. 2053 00 093 AA 01 06)" (Rs.10,32,492)

9. The expenditure for the purchase of Ambassador cars should be debited to "2053.00 -District Administration-093-District Establishments -AA- Collectors and Magistrates-21. Motor Vehicles-01-purchase" (D.P.Code 2053 00 093 AA 2113)(Rs.10.00 lakhs).

10. The expenditure for Telephone charges should be debited to "2053 00 District Administration 093 District Establishments AA Collector and Magistrates 05 Office expenses 01. (D.P.Code 2053 00 093 AA 0517) (Recurring Rs. 18,000/- per annum and Non Recurring Rs. 3,000/-)

11. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraphs 8,9, and 10 above constitute an item of " New Instrument of Service". Approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of Legislature, the expenditure will be met initially by sanction of an advance from the contingency fund for which order will be issued by Finance (BG -I) Department. The Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to apply in the prescribed format enclosing a copy of the orders for the requirement amount. He is also requested to send necessary proposal to Finance Department for inclusion of the expenditure to supplementary estimates for the year 2008-2009 and for bringing it to the notice of the Legislature in due course.
