ORDER:

In G.O.Ms.No.1829, Rural Development and Local Administration dated 9.12.83, orders were issued specifying the retirement age of NMR workers in Town Panchayats and Panchayat Union Councils as 58. As there are no specific orders regarding retirement age of NMR workers in Corporation and Municipalities, the Examiner of Local Fund Accounts has requested to clarify whether the retirement age of these NMR workers may be fixed as 60 years, since they are getting pay on par with office assistants - vide G.O.(Rt.) No.620, M&WS Department, dt.23.8.90 and if they are promoted to higher posts, their retirement age may be brought down to 58 years.

2. The Government have examined the question of prescribing the age limit for retirement of NMR workers in Municipalities and Municipal Corporations and viewed that the regularisation or permanent retention of NMRs is itself a concession and not something they are entitled. Hence, there is no need to extend to them the provision of the Fundamental Rules which are applicable to these properly and validly appointed persons. Further, merely because orders have been issued to the effect that the NMR workers in the Municipalities are eligible for the service benefits as applicable to the basic servants, they cannot claim as a matter of right that they are eligible for the retirement of the age of 60 years. The Government accordingly direct that the retirement age of NMR workers in Municipalities and Municipal Corporations shall be 58 (fifty eight) years.


3. The Director of Municipal Administration and all special officers are requested to bring the contents of this order to the notice of all Municipalities and Municipal Corporations.
