In paragraph 4 of the over Government Order, the Director of Municipal Administration requested to review the working of the lease of fishery ents of municipal water sources to Fishermen Cooperative creties and send a report to the Government, The matter was skined in detail in consultation with the Board of Revenue (FP), was and the Director of Municipal Administration, Madras.

The Director of Municipal Administration has reported to at there are no tanks belonging to the municipalities and no stered Fisherman Co-operative Societies are functioning in Cipalities and Municipal townships committees, except in Tuchirapalli, Chidambaram, Rumbakonam, Mannargudi and Arni micipalities and Avadi Township Committee where such tanks are

leased out in public auction for fishing. It has been reported that Fish Farmers Development Agencies are also fur functioning in Tiruchirapalli, Thanjavur, South Arcot and Chengalpattu Districtswill and during 1982-83 the North Arcol District will also have an agency. District will also have an agency. The Government therefore direct that where there are Fisherman Cooperative colleties functioning in the municipalities and municipal townships, preference may be given to these Co-operative Societies for leasing out the fishery rights of Municipal tanks and where there are no such Co-operative Societies, the right of fishing in municipal tanks may be given to the Fish Farmers Development Agencies functioning in the districts. In the ab of both the Fisherman Cooperative Societies in the municipall and the Fish Farmers Development Agencies, the right of fishing in municipal tanks may be leased out in public auttion.
