ORDER:

In the G.O.first read above, orders were issued fixing the norms for classification and reclassification of 8 Municipal Townships as Grade II. Grade I and Selection Grade on the basis of the income.

2. In the G.O. Second read above, orders were issued revising the norms of income prescribed for classification of Municipalities in tune with the increase in the income and expenditure levels of Municipalities due to the inflationary trends in the general economy of the State. The norms fixed for classification/ reclassification of Municipalities are as follows:--

<u>Grade of Municipality</u>	<u>Revised Norms</u> (Average total income under all accounts for the past 4 years, including income under electrical undertaking but excluding loans, lapsed deposits, non-recurring grants (non-statutory))
Special Grade	.. Above Rs.200.00 lakhs
Selection Grade	.. above Rs.100.00 lakhs
First Grade	.. above Rs. 40.00 lakhs
Second Grade	.. above Rs. 20.00 lakhs
Third Grade	.. above Rs. 10.00 lakhs

3. In the letter third read above, the Commissioner of Municipal Administration has requested orders revising the norms for classification and reclassification of the Township Committees.

4. In the Government letter fourth read above, the Commissioner of Municipal Administration has been informed that the norms for classification of Municipal Townships can be the same as for Municipalities.

5. In the letter ~~first~~^{4th} read above the Commissioner of Municipal Administration has reiterated his earlier request for classification/reclassification of Municipal Townships.

6. The Government have examined the proposal of the Commissioner of Municipal Administration carefully and direct that the norms for classification and reclassification of Municipal Townships be the same as those fixed for the Municipalities, as indicated in para 2 above.
