### ORDER:-

According to the provision contained in Para 5.56 (v) in the Municipal Manual Volume II, in cases where a Municipal Council desires to prefer an appeal or revision against any judgment order or decree of a count, the previous sanction of the Commissioner of Municipal Administration should be obtained." The Commissioner of Municipal Administration has now reported that since elected council is now functioning the provision entry wering the Commissioner of Municipal Administration to accord previous sanction for filing appeal may be deleted. The Government after careful consideration have decided to modify the provisions contained in para 5.56 (v) in the Municipal Manual Volume II. Accordingly, the Government issue the following amendment to Para 5.56 (v) of Municipal Manual Volume II.

# <u>AMENDMENT</u>

For the provision in para 5.56 (v) of Municipal Manual Volume II, the

### following provinces Mail be substituted :-

"In cases, where a municipal council desires to prefer an appeal or revision against any judgment order or decree of a court, the municipal council can do so based on the legal opinion and on the remarks of the Commissioner. However, if the council decides either way (for filing or not filing of appeal) over ruling the remarks of the Commissioner and also the legal opinion of the Standing Counsel, the matter shall be reported, by the Commissioner to the Commissioner / Director of Municipal Administration for a decision and his decision shall be final."
