## NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (2) of section 23-A and section 303 of the Tamil Nadu District Municipalities Act, 1920 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1920), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Municipal Taxation Appeals Committee (Transaction of Business) Rules, 1988.

### AMENDMENT.

In the said Rules, after rule 10, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:-

"10-A Disposal of the appeal petition by the Committee.- The Committee shall examine the legality or otherwise of the orders passed by the executive authority in the light of the provisions contained in the Act and the rules made thereunder and the guidelines issued by the Government, from time to time. The Committee may allow, modify or remit the appeal to the executive authority for reconsideration."
