ORDER:

In the Govt. Order second and fourth readabove, instructions were issued about the display of portraits of leads; in public offices and Public buildings. Doubts have been raised whether these instructions supersede the previous instructions issued on the subject and if so, whether the other portraits may removed. Clarifications have also been sought whether the portraits of the former Presidents and Prime Ministers of India may be removed. The Govt. after careful consideration, have lecided to issue the following instructions in supersession of all the previous instructions issued on the subject.

- 2. The portraits of the following personalities may alore be displayed in publicoffices and buildings:-
 - 1. The incumbent President of India
 - 2. The incumbent Prime Minister of India
 - 3. Mahatma Gandhi
 - 1. Pandit Jawaharlal Nohru

The portrait of the incumbent President of India should be (isplayed immediately behind and above the seat of important Government Officers exercising Judicial, Megisterial, Police and Revenue powers and functions.

- 3. The portraits of the following departed leaders of Tamil Madu may also be displayed in Public offices and Public buildings
 - 1. Saint Thiruvalluvar
 - 2. Arigner Anna
 - 3. Thiru K.Kamaraj
 - 4. Thiru C.Rajagopalachari
 - 5. Thanthai Poriyar

- 4. The pictures should be of uniform size and should fit in with the size of pictures, if any, already on display in Public Offices and public buildings. Only the approved copies obtained from the public (Information and public Relations) Department should be utilised.
- 5. The portraits of all others may be removed from public offices and Bublic Buildings.
- 6. The expenditure involved in thextersky reduced this connection should be met from "Office Contingencies" of the respective offices.
- 7. The display of portraits in the local bodies and in the educational institutions will be governed by the orders issued by the Government in the Rural Development and Local Administration Department and the Education Department respectively.
- 8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.54/FS/P/78,dt:5.1.78.
