## ORDER :-

In the G.O. third read above, instructions were issued only for the display of portraits referred to therein in Public Offices and buildings and the portraits of all others should be removed. It has also been ordered therein that the display of portraits in the Educational Institutions will be governed by the orders issued in the Education Department in the matter.

2. The Government have examined the metter in consultation with the Director of School Education, Director of Collegiate Education and the Director of Technical Education and after careful consideration, they issue the following instructions in the matter:

The portraits of the following personalities alone may be displayed in the educational institutions:-

- i) The incumbent President of India
- ii) The incumbent Prime Minister of India
- iii) Mahatma Gandhi
  - iv) Pandit Jawaharial Nehru.
- 2. The portraits of the following departed leaders of Tamil Nadu may also be displayed in Educational Institutions:
  - i) Saint Thiruvalluvar
  - ii) Arignar Anna
  - iii) Thiru K.Kamarai
  - iv) Thiru C.Rajag cpalachari
  - v) Thanthai Periyar
- 3. Specific orders of Government shouldbe obtained for displaying the portraits of leaders other than those montioned above.
- 4. The pictures should be of uniform size and should fit in with the size of pictures, if any already on display in educational institutions. Only the approved

copies obtained from the Public (information and public Relations) Department should be utilised)

- 5. The expenditure in respect of Government Educational Institutions should be met from the Office contingencies. The expenditure in respect of aided educational institutions should be met only from private funds.
- 6. The portraits of the officers of the Education Department should not be displayed. However, the portraits of the retired Headmasters, Philanthropists, who have donated for the building, Thiru Subash Chandra Bose, Subremania Bharathi, Ramalinga Swamigal Budha, Jesus Christs, Dr. U. V. Swaminatha Iyer, Sir, C. V. Raman and the like already displayed in Educational Institutions need not be removed.
