ORDER:

According to Rule 1 of the House Building Advance Rules, "House Building Advance may be sanctioned to the Government servants, including All India Service Officers, whether permanent or non-permanent, if they have rendered on the date of application for the advance 6 (six) years' continuous regular service".

2. Recently, certain officers, who have not completed 6 years regular service have applied for house building advance. The Government, after a careful examination of the issue, consider that the Government servants when once they are confirmed in a service may also be made eligible for the grant of House Building Advance. The Government, therefore, direct that the house building advance applications of the Government servants may be entertained, if they are either confirmed in their service or put in 6 years of continuous regular service, whichever is earlier.

3. This order will take effect from the date of the issue of this Government Order. The sanctioning authorities of House Building Advance are requested to follow the instructions contained in para 2 above strictly in future.

4. The following amendment is issued to the State Rules to regulate the grant of advance to State Government Servants for building etc. of houses.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in Rule 1, after the word "Eligibility" the following shall be substituted:-

"House Building Advance may be sanctioned to the Government Servants, including All India Service Officers, if they have rendered on the date of application for the advance 6 (six) years continuous regular service or if they have been confirmed in a service whichever is earlier".
