Order:

In G.O. Ms. No. 1758, E.& P.H. d/29-4-40 the Government issued orders among other things for the supply of a simple uniform consisting of shorts and shirts to men scavengers at the cost of local bodies. In Memo No. 112970/MI/73-2 R.D.L.A. d/24-9-73, the Government have again issued instructions. tions to all the Executive Authorities of Municipal councils and the Township Committees and the Madurai Corporation that the turban cloths need not be treated as uniform and only a simple uniform of shorts and shifts should be issued as specified in the G.O. first read above.

- 2. Most of the Municipal Councils have now passed resolutions requesting the Government to treat the turban cloth also as an item of uniform and allow the Municipal Councils to supply them to the Inferior and Menial Servants including Sanitary Workers at the cost of the Municipal Councils concerned. The Director of Municipal Administration who was consulted in the matter has recommended that turban cloths may also be supplied to scavengers as an item of uniform as the practice of supplying turban cloth was also in vogus, for a long time. long time.
- 2. The Government accept the recommendation of the Director of Municipal Administration and in partial modification of the sarlier orders issued on the subject, permit all the Executive Authorities of the Municipal Councils the Township Committees and the Madurai Composation to supply turban cloths also as an item of uniform for Inferior and Namial Servants including the sanitary workers.
