Orders:

According to the orders issued in the Government Orders first read above, the Pension Scheme sanctioned to the Municipal Employees shall be extended to such period of time as the employees have been contributing to the Provident Fund. The Examiner of Local Fund Accounts will work out the contribution made by each Municipal Council 6 1/2% of the current emoluments of its employees, arrive at the difference between the amount thus arrived at and that worked out at 8 1/3% of the maximum of the current emoluments of the concerned employees for all the previous years during which they were contributing to the Provident Fund and intimate to Government the amount to be collected from each municipal council and township committee.

2. Orders were issued in the memo third read above to the effect that the balance of arrear contribution (i.e. the difference between 8 1/3% and 6 1/2%) relating to the Provident Fund contributions from the date of admission to Provident Fund to 13.1.70 should be remitted to the Personal Deposit Account in instalments to be fixed by Government.

The Examiner of Local Fund Accounts has now reported that the balance of pensionary contribution payable by the Municipal councils for the period prior to 14.1.70 would not be heavy when compared to the current demand for the period from 14.1.70. He has therefore suggested that the question of fixing instalments in individual cases may be dispensed with and it would be better if orders are issued by the Government to the effect that the arrear contribution (i.e.) the difference between the 6 1/2% of Provident Fund contribution together with interest thereon and the Pensionary contribution at 8 1/3% of the maximum of the time scale of pay held by the municipal employees of the time scale of pay as on 13-1-70 shall be remitted to the Municipal employees Pension fund in 3 equal instalments as follows:-

- i) the first instalment within 30 days from the date of communication of demand by the Examiner of L.F. accounts and;
- ii) the second and third instalments at three months interval each from the date of remittance of the first instalment.

3. The Government accept the suggestion of the Examiner of L.F.Accounts in para 2 above and direct that the Executive Authorities of all the Municipal Councils and Township Committees shall remit the arrear contribution due for the period prior to 14.1.70 i.e. the difference between the 6 1/2% of Provident Fund contribution together with interest thereon and the pensionary contribution at 8 1/3% of the maximum of the time scale of pay held by the municipal employees as on 13-1-70 to the municipal employees pension fund in 3 equal instalments as indicated in para 2 above.

The Government direct that the Executive Authorities of all the Municipal Councils and Township Committees should take immediate action to remit the arrears contribution in question to the Municipal Employees Pension Fund without further loss of time.
