OFDER:

According to the procedure for the supply of typewriters and duplicators to the Local Bodies prescribed in G.O.Ms. No.2394, RDLA dt. 29.12.1967 the Inspector of Municipalities and the Director of Rural Development were requested to address the firms dealing with these machines, invite quotations from them and communicate the list of approved firms, types of machines and their price to the local bodies with instructions that they should purchase their requirements from the approved firms and at the approved rates, the cost being met from the funds of local bodies. This was done with a view to ensure that the prical vantage accruing through rate contract should be made available to the local bodies as and when they go in for these machines.

2. The Inspector of Muricipalities has reported that in practice, it was found that the majority of well establishe and reputed firms dealing with tupewriters and duplicators had expressed their unwillingness to supply these machines at contra basis of D.c. and supplies and disposals as they are not direct demanding officers. It was also noticed that there was considered delay in metting supplies. The Inspector of Municipalities, has therefore suggested that the instructions issued in G.O.Ms.No. 2394, RDLA dt.29.12.1967 might be cancelled and that the local may be permitted to purchase their requirements from the firms without inviting tenders.

- 3. The Director of Stationery and Printing Madras has suggested that the Inspector of Municipalities might named that with the firms concerned and submit proposals to covernment. In view of the delay and difficulty experienced in securing these machines from reputed right through a Central archev, the Inspector of municipal ties has since suggested that Municipal councils might be permitted to purchase their requirements of typewriters and duplicators from the open market after following the prescribed formalities.
- 4. The coverament have carefully examined the question in detail and accept the succession of the Inspector of Municipalities. They accordingly permit the Municipal Councils to purchase their requirements of typeriters and duplicators from the open market after following the prescribed formalities. The orders issued in C.O.Ms. No.2324, Mural development and local administration department dated 29.12.1967 will stand modified so far as they relate to municipalities.
 - 5. The receipt of this C.O. may be acknowledged.
