ABSTRACT

INDIGENOUS MEDICINE - Change of Nomenclature as 'Indian
Medicine' - Orders passed.

ORDER:

In G.O. Ms. No. 4159, Public Health dated 23.11.1949, it was ordered that the expression, 'Indigenous Medicine' should be used while referring to the systems of medicines peculiar to India, such as Siddha, Ayurveda and Unani. The three systems of medicine, namely Siddha, Ayurveda and Unani, are not commonly known as 'Indian Medicine'. The Central Act relating to Indian Systems of Medicine has been termed as 'Central Council of Indian Medicine Act'. The Government, have, therefore, decided that the Directorate of Indigenous Medicine and the Director of Indigenous Medicine be renamed as 'Directorate of Indian Medicine' and 'Director of Indian Medicine' respectively.

2. The Director of Indian Medicine is requested to submit to Government draft amendments to the Special Rules etc and proposals for renaming Institutions, wherever necessary.
