APSTRACT

Loans and Advances - House Building Advance - Allocation of funds during 1994-95 for sanction of house building advance to Government Servants Other than Panchayat Union School Teachers - Orders Issued.

ORDER

In the Government Orders read above, orders have been issued, permitting all the sanctioning authorities to sanction House Building Advance to Government servants, other than Panchayat Union School Teachers, during the year 1993-94, as indicated therein.

- 2. A provision of Rs.3300 lakhs has been made in the Budget Estimate 1994-95 for the sanction ofHouse Building Advance totale Government Servants other than Panchayat Union School Teachers. The Government have examined the question of providing funds among the sanctioning authorities for sanction of House Building Advance to the Government Servants during 1994-95 with reference tothe availability of funds. The Government have decided to allocate the total allotment made in the Budget Estimate to various districts and Secretariat in proportionate to number of applications pending as on 31.3.1994.
- 3. The Government, accordingly permit all the sanctioning authorities to sanction House Building Advance to the Government Servants other than Fancha at Union School Teachers during the year 1994-95, for the pending applications which are in a complete shape. The sanction should be accorded as per strict seniority only. The sanctioning authorities are requested to ensure that the rules and procedures laid down for the sanction of House Building Advance are strictly adhered to, while according formal sanction/sanction for the release of advance/instalments of the House Building Advance. The Government direct that no funds should be surrendered, under any circumstances.
- 4. The amount allocated to each sanctioning authority for the sanction of House Building Advance for pending applications in all categories including Peady Built House (Tamil Nadu Housing Board) is detailed in the Annexure I. Out of the total amount shown in the Annexure I, the amount to the allocated to the Ready Built House (Tamil Nadu Housing Board) alone is shown in Annexure II.
- 5. The sanctioning authorities are requested to apportion the total amount allocated to their Districts, after d ducting the amount allotted for Ready Built House (Tamil Nadu Housing Board) in proportionate to the number of applications pending in each category of loan viz., loan for Ready Built House (Private), Plot-cum-Construction, Construction, Additional Advance, Enlargement and Improvement etc.,

- 6. The sanctioning authorities viz., the District Collectors should ensure that the total expenditure on account of the House Fuilding Advance sanctioned by them does not exceed the amount allocated to them. They should also mention specifically in their proceedings, releasing the advance regarding the availability of funds out of the amount allocated to their districts to cover the expenditure as ordered in the Government Order read above. In respect of Changai M.G.P., Than javur, Madurai and Madras Districts, the Collectors concerned should reallocate the amount among the Treasuries/Pay and Accounts Offices in their respective districts with reference to the pending applications and proceedings sanctioning the advance.
- 7. The Treasury Officers/Pay and Accounts Officers are requested to ensure that the expenditure on account of the drawals under house kuilding advance in respect of the sanctions made by the District Collectors does not exceed the amount allocated to the Collector of the respective district.
- 8. All the Collectors are requested to send the statement of departmental figures of expenditure under House Building Advance, duly reconciled with the Treasury figures so as to reach the Government by 20th of each month positively.
- 9. The Collectors are requested to send a report to Government every quarter in the following format:-
 - (i) Category of advance
 - (ii) Opening amount
 - (iii) Amount sanctioned during the quarter.
 - (iv) No. of applications upto which sanction was accorded.
 - (v) Date of application upto which sanction was accorded.
 - (vi) Closing Bolance.
 - (vii) Whether any application has been overlooked. if so, reason therefor.
