Act - The Tamil Nadu Public Huildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 1965) - Time limit for, submission of application for licence prescribed under Section 4 of the Act - use of buildings (not being existing public buildings) as Public buildings and existing public buildings - Extension upto 31st March 1972 -Notification - issued.

Letter from the Secretary, Southern India Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Madras-1 dated 3rd February 1971.

ORDER:

Under section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 1965), no building, not being an existing public publiding, shall be used as a public publicing without a licence on and after the commencement of the Act. On and after the date of expiry of a period of one year from the date of commencement of the Act, no existing public building shall be used as a public building without a licence. Under section 4 of the Said Act, any owner; who intends to use any building (not being an existing public building) as public building, shall make an application in writing to the as public building, shall make an application in writing to the competent authority for licence therefor. Any owner, who intends to continue to use an existing public building shall, before the date of expiry of a period of six months from the date of commencement of the Act, make similar application for licence. The Act came into force with effect from the 1st April 1966.

- 2. In the Government order read above, the Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 20 of the Tamil adu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 1965), lastly extended the time limit upto the 31st March 1971 for submitting applications for licence under section 4 of the said. Act. The Southern India Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Madras has now requested in its letter read above to extend the time limit for submitting applications for licence beyond the 31st March 1971 for the reasons put forth for licence beyond the 31st March 1971 for the reasons put forth by them. The Government after careful examination of the request have decided to extend the above time limit for submitting applications for licence for a further period of oneyear upto the 31st March 1972.

NOTIFICATIONS.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 1965), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts existing public buildings from the operation of the time limit of six months prescribed in the sub-section (2) of section 4 of the said Act for further period of one year on and from the 1st April 1971.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act)13 of 1965), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts the existing public buildings from the provisions of sub-section(2) of Section 3 and clause (ii) of sub-section (4) of section 6 of the said Act for a further period of one year on and from the 1st April 1971.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act af 13 of 1965), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts the use of buildings (not being existing public buildings) as public buildings from the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 3 and sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the said Act.

This exemption shall cease to be in force on the 1st April 1972.
