Act - The Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing)Act, 1965-Time-limit for submission of application for licence prescribed under section 4 of the Act - Use of buildings (not being existing public buildings) as public buildings and existing public buildings - Extension up to 31st March 1971-Notifications - Issued. READ--the following papers:--

G.O.Ms.No.603, Rural Development and Local Administration, dated 31st March 1969. Representation from Various Merchants' Association.

Order -- No. 474, Rural Development and Local Administration, dated 18th March 1970.

Under section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings Under section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 1965) no building, not being an existing public buildings, shall be used as a public building without a licence on and after the commencement of the Act. On and after the date of the expiry of a period of one year from the date of the commencement of the Act, no existing public building shall be used as a public building without a licence. Under section 4 of the Act any owner, who intends to use any building (not being an existing public building) as public building. Shall make an archication in building) as public building, shall make an arrlication in writing to the competent authority for licence therefor.

Any owner, who intends to continue to use an existing public building, shall, before the date of the expiry of a period of six months from the date of the commencement of the date. of six months from the date of the commencement of the Act, make similar application for licence. The Act came into force with effect from the 1st A pril 1965.

- 2. In the Government Order read above, the Government in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 20 of the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 lastly extended the time-limit upto the 31st March 1970 for submitting applications for licence under Station 4 of the said Act: Various Merchants' Association have represented to the Government to repeal the said Act for varied reasons put forth by them. Government, after taking into consideration all aspects of the question, have decided to extend the time limit for submitting applications for licence for a further period of one year upto aspects. of the the 31st March 1971.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing)Act, 1965(Tamil Nadu Act 13 of 1965) the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts the use of huildings (not being existing public hulldings) as public huildings from the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 3 and sub-section (1) of section 4 of the said Act.

This exemption shall cease to be in force on the 1st April 1971.
