The Chief Electrical Inspector to Government has brought to the notice of Government that buildings are being constructed under the power lines without proper clearance specified in rule 80 of the Indian Electricity Rules 1956. As this is very serious and would cause accidents, the Commissioners of Municipalities are requested to see that any building work to be taken up or any modification to the existing buildings taken up, if they happen to be near the power lines are approved, only after referring to the respective electrical supply authority of the area and obtaining necessary clearance from them, to avoid eletrical accidents.
