Act - Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 - Exemption of certain categories of buildings from the provisions of the Act for a further period of three years from 1st April, 1969. Notification issued.

Order--G.O.No.453, Rural Development and Local Administration, dated 11th March 1969.

The Government have exempted certain classes of Public buildings from the provisions of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 for a period of three years from 1st April 1966 in the notifications issued with the Government Orders read above. The Government have decided to exempt those classes of public buildings from the provisions of the said Act for a further period of three years from 1st April, 1969.

2. The following notification will be published in the Fort St. George Gazette--

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of powers conferred by section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act 13 of 1965), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts the following classes of public buildings from all the provisions of the said Act for a further period of three years from the 1st April, 1969:--

- 1) All temples, mosques, churches and gurudwaras.
- 2) All buildings used by associations or clubs with a floor area of less than 250 sq.ft.
- 3) Consulting rooms at the residence of doctors.
- 4) All buildings owned by Army, Navy, Air Force, Defence Science Organisation and the Ordnance Factories under the Ministry of Defence.
- 5) All buildings used for purpose of running the Seminaries.
- 6) All small shops whose floor area does not exceed 11.61 square metres (125 square feet).
