In G.O.Ms.No.167, RD & L.A., dated 3-2-68 orders have been issued that if the remarks of the Health Section are not received within the specified period of one week, the Town Planning section may dispose of the building applications. It has now been pointed out that there is considerable delay on the part of Town Planning staff also in disposal of Building applications and that suitable instructions may be issued in the matter.

2. The question has been examined by the Government. In Municipalities, the Town Planning section deals with the receipt and disposal of building applications. Instructions have already been issued to the municipalities in the proceedings No.16540/68-CA, dated 25-5-68 of the Director of Town Planning to avoid delays and to have prompt dealings in case of Building applications. The Government therefore consider that it would be sufficient if the Executive Authority issues an office order to the effect that the building Inspectors should offer their remarks on building applications within one week. All Executive Authorities of municipal councils are requested to take action accordingly.
