Under section 3 of the Mødras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Mødras Act 13 of 1965) no building, not being am existing public building, shall be used as a ru'lic huildin- without a licence on and after the commen-Act no existin- ublic buildin- shall makexamxampakexamxam inxmaximimizations be used as a pulic buildin- without a litence. Under section-4 of the Act any owner-who intends to use any buildin- (not bein- an existin- public buildin-) as a rublic buildin- shall make an appliction in writin- to the commetent authority for licence therefor. In owner who intends to continue to use an existin- public buildin- shall, before the date of expirty of a eriod of six tonths from the date of commencement of the Act, make a similar application for licence. The Act came into force with effect from Ist April 1966.

2. In the government Orders second to fourth cited, the lovernment in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 extended the time-limit up to 31st March 1968 for submitting in 15 cations for licence under section 4 of the Said Act. It has now been decided to extend the above time-limit for a further meriod up to 31st March, 1968.

MUTIFIC TIOMS.

In excercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Madras Public Luildings Licensing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act Mo. 13 of 1965), the governor of Madras hereby exempts the existing public buildings from the operation of the time-limit of six months prescribed in sub-section (2) of section 4 of the said Act for a further reriod of one year on and from the 1st April, 1968.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Madras Fublic Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act Mo. 13 of 1965), the governor of Madras hereby exem to the existing public buildings from the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 3 and clause (ii) of sub-section (4) of section 6 of the said Act for a further region of one year on and from the Ist Arril 1968.
