Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965--Time-limit for ~~xxxx~~ submission of application for licence prescribed under section 4 of the Act--Use of buildings (not being existing public buildings) as public buildings and existing public buildings--Extension upto 31st March 1969--Notifications-- Issued.

Order--vol 573, Rural Development and Local Administration, dated 22nd March 1968.

Under section 3 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act 13 of 1965) no building, not being an existing public building, shall be used as a public building without a licence on and after the commencement of the Act. On and after the date of expiry of a period of one year from the date of commencement of the Act no existing public building shall ~~make any application~~ be used as a public building without a licence. Under section 4 of the Act any owner who intends to use any building (not being an existing public building) as a public building shall make an application in writing to the competent authority for licence therefor. Any owner who intends to continue to use an existing public building shall, before the date of expiry of a period of six months from the date of commencement of the Act, make a similar application for licence. The Act came into force with effect from 1st April 1966.

2. In the Government Orders second to fourth cited, the Government in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 extended the time-limit up to 31st March 1968 for submitting applications for licence under section 4 of the Said Act. It has now been decided to extend the above time-limit for a further period up to 31st March, 1968.

3. The following notifications will accordingly be published in the Fort St. George Gazette.

NOTIFICATIONS.

I

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings Licensing Act, 1965 (Madras Act No. 13 of 1965), the governor of Madras hereby exempts the existing public buildings from the operation of the time-limit of six months prescribed in sub-section (2) of section 4 of the said Act for a further period of one year on and from the 1st April, 1968.

(II)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act No. 13 of 1965), the governor of Madras hereby exempts the existing public buildings from the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 3 and clause (ii) of sub-section (4) of section 6 of the said Act for a further period of one year on and from the 1st April 1968.

III

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act No. 13 of 1965), the governor of Madras hereby exempts the use of buildings (not being existing public buildings) as public buildings from the provision of sub-section (I) of section 3 and sub-section (1) of section 4 of the said Act.

This exemption shall cease to be in force on the 1st April 1969.
