Sub: MADRAS PUBLIC BUILDINGS (LICENCING) ACT, 1965-
Time-limit for submission of application for licence prescribed under Sec.4 of the Act-use of buildings (not being existing public buildings) as public buildings and existing public buildings -extension upto 31-5-68 - notification - issued.

ORDER:

Under sub-section 1 of Section 3 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing Act, 1965 no building not being an existing public building shall be used as a public building without a licence on and after the commencement of the Act. Under Sub-Section(1) of Section 4 of the Act any owner who intends to use any building (not being an existing public building) as a public building shall make an application in writing to the competent authority for a licence therefor. The act came into force with effect from 1.4.66.

2. In the Government orders second and third cited, the Government in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 20 of the M.P.B.(I) Act, 1965 extended the time-limit for submitting applications for licence under sub-section (2) of the Section 4 of the Act for the ~~xxxxxx~~ period upto 30.9.67, in respect of the existing public buildings. It has now been decided to extend the time-limit for a further period upto 31.3.68. It has also been decided to extend this concession for making application for licence for the use of building (not being existing public building) as public buildings.

3. The following notifications will be accordingly be published in the Fort St. George Gazette.

NOTIFICATION. I.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licencing) Act, 1965

(Madras Act No.13 of 1965) the Governor of Madras hereby exempts the existing public buildings from the operation of the time-limit of six months prescribed in sub-section(2) of section 4 of the said act for a further period of six months on and from the 1st October, 1967.

NOTIFICATION . II.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licencing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act No: 13 of 1965) the Governor of Madras hereby exempts the existing public buildings from the provision of sub-section 2 of section 3 and class (ii) of sub-Section (4) of Section 6 of the said Act for a further period of one year on and from the 1st April, 1967.

NOTIFICATION . III.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licencing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act No:13 of 1965) the Governor of Madras hereby exempts the use of buildings (not being existing public buildings) as public buildings from the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 3 and sub section (1) of Section 4 of the said Act.

This exemption shall cause to be in force on the 1st April, 1967.
