Order.

In the G.O. second cited, the Government in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 extended for a period of six months the existing Public Buildings from the operation of the time limit of six months prescribed under subsection (2) of Section 4 of the said Act. It has now been represented that it is necessary to extend the time limit for a further period. The Government have, therefore, decided to extend the time limit for a further period of six months from 1st April 1967.

- 2. The time-limit prescribed under sub-section (2) of Section 3 and sub-section (4) (ii) of Section 6 of the Act will not operate if the time-limit is extended for a further period of six months from 1-4-1967 as decided in para 1 above. They have also decided to exempt the operation of the time limit for a period of one year from 1-4-1967.
- 3. The following notifications will accordingly published in the Fort St. George Gazette.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the Madras ublic Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act No.15 of 1965) and in continuation of the Notification No.1243 of 1966, published at page one in part III of the Fort St. George Gazette Extraordinary, dated the 1st October 1966, the Government of Madras hereby exempts the existing public buildings from the operation of the time-limit of six months prescribed in sub-section (2) of Section4 of the said Act. the said Act.

This exemption shall be in force for a turther period of six months with effect on and from the 1st April 1967. (Contd.,)

NOTIFICATION II.

In exercise of the Powers conferred by Section 20 of the Madras Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Madras Act No.13 of 1965), the overnor of Madras hereby exempts the existing public buildings from the provisions of subsection (2) of Section 3 and clause (ii) of sub-section (4) of section 6 of the said Act.

This exemption shall be in force for a period of one year with effect on and from the 1st April 1967.
