ORDER:

The Commissioner, Srivilliputtur Municipality has raised a general question regarding the applicability of rule 10 of the Building rule to the Bunks and Box stalls. The question has been examined in consultation with the Director of Town Planning, Madras, the Chief Engineer (Highways and Rural Works) and the CHIEF Engineer, Public works Department (General), Madras. The Government consider that the Box stall or bunk (Whether stationary or movable) cannot be classified as a living room in as much as it is not intended for human habitation and that rule 10 of the Building Rules framed under the Madras District Municipalities Act, 1920, will not be applicable to such bunks and box stalls.
