ORDER:-

In continuation of the orders issued in G.O. Ms.No.865, Local administration, dated 30th May 1957, the Government hereby direct that the qualifications and the method of recruitment specified in columns (2) and (3) respectively of the schedule below shall apply to the posts mentioned in column (1) thereof:-
