In Letters Patent Appeals Nos. 100 and 101 of 1951 disposed of by the Division Bench of the Madras High Court on 7th April 1954, the Court has given the following interpretation of the definition of the word "building" and of the implication of section 215 of the Madras District Municipalities Act.

The mere demolition and reconstruction of the walls on new foundations will not amount to reconstruction of a building. The word 'affect' in (the proviso to) Section 215 of the Madras District Municipalities Act should be given a liberal interpretation so as to mean materially and substantially affect and not technically or mathematically affect the dimensions of a building. The Director of Town Planning, the executive authorities of Municipalities and Panchayats are informed that the above interpretation should be given effect to when administering the Madras District Municipalities Act and the Building Rules.
