DRAFT AMENDMENTS.

In the said rules-(1) for the sub-heading "Proximity of Electric supply Lines-- withholding of permission" to rule 4, the sub-heading "Proximity of Conductors or Aerial Lines-withholding of permission" shall be substituted:

(2) in rule 4--

- (a) in sub-rule (1) for the words "electric supply lines", the words "aerial lines" shall be substituted;
- (b) in sub-rule(2)
 (1) for the words "electric lines", the workds "acrial lines" shall be subs-

tituted and
(2) for sub-clauses (a), (b) and (c) the following sub-clauses shall be substituted namely:--

(a) 5 feet for low tension lines and 6 feet for hightension lines from accessible portions of buildings measured horizontally, and 4' for both low-tension

- (b) 8 feet from portions of buildings not accessible to persons, measured vertically and
