ORDER:

In the letter read above the Director of Municipal Administration has stated that consequent on the decision of the Government to extend the Self Sufficiency Programme to the financially weak municipalities from 1982-83 onwards, the proposal to implement the scheme in 20 Municipalities in the 1st instance during 1982-83 has been approved by the Government that each of these Municipalities has to execute works costing Rs.25 lakhs under the scheme during the year and that out of these 20 Municipalities 17 are in II and III grades the remaining 3 being in I Grade. He has also stated that the above programme is likely to be extended to further batches of Municipalities during the next year and that besides the Self Sufficiency programme many of the Municipalities have works under the Integrated Urban Development Programme sponsored by the Central and State Governments resulting in spending of very heavy amounts on various developmental activities in the II and III Grade Municipalities. He has suggested that it is desirable to entrust the functions of Chairman of the Municipal Council and the Council to separate Special Officers other than the executive authorities, viz., the Commissioner in II and III Grade Municipalities as well. In the light of the above back ground and with a view to facilitate speedy execution of works taken under Self Sufficiency Scheme and the Integrated Urban Development Programme and to ensure efficient administration, the Director of Municipal Administration has suggested that the functions of Council and Chairman in all II and III Grade Municipalities may be exercised by separate Special Officers of higher status. He has accordingly proposed that 59 Municipalities i.e. all the 56 II and III Grade ones and the three I Grade Municipalities at

Madakottai, Nagercoil and Dindigul of which the Collectors of the Districts or District Revenue Officers are the Special Officers at present, may be divided into 14 groups, each group consisting of 3 or four contiguous Municipalities may have the services of one Special Officer in the rank of Senior Grade II Municipal Commissioner. (Selection Grade) in the scale of Rs.850-50-1200-60-1500/- to exercise the functions of Council, Chairman and Committee. He has further stated that the cost of appointment of 14 Special Officers may be apportioned among the Municipalities concerned. The Government have examined the proposals of the Director of Municipal Administration and decide to accept the proposal.

2. Sanction is accorded to the creation of 14 posts of Special Officers in the Senior Grade II (Selection Grade) Municipal Commissioners in the scale of Rs.850-50-1200-60-1500/- for a period of six months from the date of appointment in the first instance or till the date of assumption of office by the elected Council in the concerned Municipalities whichever is earlier to exercise the functions of Council and Chairman in respect of 59 Municipalities as grouped in the Annexure to this order. The expenditure towards the employment of the Special Officers should be borne by the Municipalities concerned on equal sharing basis.

3. The Director of Municipal Administration is requested to take necessary follow up action to implement the above orders.
