ORDER

The Self Sufficiency Scheme intended to create infrastrucutral facilities on a time-bound basis to hasten the economic activity has been extended to the Town Panchayats areas also and the 620 Town Panchayats in the State will be covered by the above Scheme in three years. The Government have selected 146 fown Panchayats for the implementation of the Self Sufficiency Scheme in the first batch in 1982-83.

- 2. Under this Scheme, the following basic amenities are to be provided:-
 - (i) Protected drinking water supply (The major water supply works such as bore wells, comprehensive scheme and construction of over head tanks will be entrusted to the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board and the Town Panchayats will undertake only minor items like deepening of existing wells, extension of pipe-lines and minor repairs to the existing works).
 - (ii) Link Roads
 - (iii) Culverts
 - (iv) Drainage facilities
 - (v) Pathways to burning ghats/ burial grounds from Adi-Dravidar colonies.
 - (vi) Street lighting in habitations of weaker communities
 - (vii) Construction of Dhobikhanas.

- 3. A sum of Rs.3.42 lakhs has been sanctioned to each of the 146 Town Panchayats for implementation of the scheme. An amount of Rs.5.00 Crores has been provided in the Budget 1982-83 for this purpose. In the Government Order fourth read above, the procedure and guide-lines for the implementation of the scheme have been issued:-
- 4. The Director of Town Panchayats has furnished a list of works proposed to be takenup under the scheme at a cost of Rs.641.2 lakhs a detailed below:-

The Government approve the above physical and financial targets submitted by the Director of Town Panchayats. The expenditure this year will however be restricted to the provision in the bueget i.e. Rs.5.00 crores. District-wise breakup of the targets approved above are given in the Annexure-I to this Order.

- 5. The Government also direct that water supply works of the above approved water supply works as mentioned in the Annexure-II to this order be executed by the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board.
- 6. The Government also accord sanction for the release of a total sum of Rs.3,74,49,000 (Rupees three crores seventy four lakhs and forty nine thousand only) being the grant for the three quarters viz., 31.6.1982, 31.9.1982 and 31.12.1982 for the Self Sufficiency Scheme Works as detailed below:-

- 7. The District Collectors are requested to allocate the grant sanctioned above to the Self Sufficiency Scheme Town Panchayats concerned, category-wise, according to their requirements, and mark a copy of the order of allocation to the Director of Town Panchayats/Government. The Director of Town Panchayat is requested to watch the utilisation of the grant.
- 8. The works taken up under the Self Sufficiency Scheme for execution shall be given top priority and the Collectors shall ensure their completion before 31.3.1983 without in any way sacrificing the quality and standard of different categories of works.
 - 9. The Tamil Nadu Electricity Board is requested to give preference to application for street lighting facilities in the habitations of Adi-Dravidars in the Self Sufficiency Scheme Town Panchayats.
 - 10. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department Vide its U.O.No.642/JS(N)/82 dated 27.11.1982.
