ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, administrative sanction was accorded for the Pillur-II Water Supply Improvement Scheme, Coimbatore, with the following funding pattern as approved by the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee on 28.12.2006:

- 2. In the letter second read above, the Commissioner, Coimbatore Corporation has stated that the Water Supply Scheme comprised of six packages, of which five packages have been implemented by Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation were completed. As a temporary arrangement, 30 MLD of raw water drawn from Pillur-I Scheme maintained by TWAD Board is being treated and supplied to the water scarcity areas in the erstwhile Corporation. The Package-I comprising construction of raw water collection well and laying pumping main upto the Tunnel entry point is being implemented by TNEB.
- 3. The Commissioner, Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation has also submitted the Council resolution (No.83, dated 01.06.2012) to the effect that the approved ULB contribution and the excess amount over and above the overall approved cost of Rs.46.12 crore will be met out of the general fund of the Corporation.
- 4. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration in his letter third read above, has stated that the estimate was originally prepared for Rs.113.74 crore based on the PWD and TWAD Board schedule of rates for the year 2006-07. During execution, modifications had to be made in view of the site conditions and past experience in the implementation of previous water supply scheme, with the concurrence of the competent authority. Because of this and due to the excess tender premium, the cost for construction work has come to Rs.147.65 crore, O&M for 5 years has come to Rs.12.20 crore, the final project cost of Rs.159.85 crore. The above modifications have been reported then and there in the progress reports submitted to Government of India for reviews. During execution, the work has also been inspected by Independent Review and Monitoring Agency (IRMA) during February 2010, May 2010 and August 2010.
- 5. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration has requested the Government to accord revised Administrative Sanction for Pillur-II Water Supply Improvement Scheme under UIG of JnNURM for Rs.159.85 crore (construction work Rs.147.65 crore + O&M for 5 years Rs.12.20 crore) with the following funding pattern:

The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Municipal Administration above, accord revised administrative sanction to the tune of Rs.159.85 crore (Rupees One Hundred and Fifty Nine Crore and Eighty Five Lakh Only) to Pillur-II Water Supply Improvement Scheme of Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation with the revised funding pattern as mentioned in para 5 above.
- 7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.58322/MAWS /2013, dated.28.10.2013.
