

CONTRIBUTION TO FAMILY WELFARE PROGRAMME CAMPS.

The Government permit the Municipalities, Corporation of Madurai and Coimbatore to contribute from their general funds accounts to the Family Welfare discretionary funds of the respective Collectors to the maximum extent possible consistent with their resources subject to a minimum contribution of Rs.5000/- for the conduct of Family Welfare camps in their districts during the year 1987-88.

The Government further permit the Municipalities having surplus General Funds in excess of Rs.3,00,000/-

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as on 1.4.87 to contribute a sum of Rs.25,000/- over and above Rs.5000/- referred to in para 1 above, to the Family welfare discretionary fund of the respective collector for the conduct of F.W. Camps in their districts during 1987-88. The condition contemplated in G.O.Ms.No:1531/D&LA/Dt:29.7.75 for the Utilization of Surplus funds, will not apply to the contribution of Rs.25,000/- referred to above.

The Government direct that the 36 persons concerned now working in General Branch by the re-transfer from 1982 onwards, be given pay protection, that is pay they were drawing on the date of re-transfer to the General-branch and their pay after 16.7.82 be regulated in the scale of pay admissible in the Gen-Branch in the subsequent year. The Municipal Commissioner, Thanjavur is directed to take action to fix the pay of the 36 persons concerned as indicated.

Family Welfare Programme:

Utilisation of BLOCK JEEPS - FUEL Ceiling.

The Government have issued the following orders for the period upto 31.3.88.

(1) The Government permit the collectors to use Block Vehicles for family welfare programme work for the period upto 31.3.88 to draw additional fuel at the rate not exceeding one hundred liters of petrol per month per vehicle or corresponding equivalent quantity of diesel (50 liters of diesel) for diesel driven vehicles till 31.3.88.

(2) not exceeding 300 liters per month for all the petrol driven family welfare vehicles including Family Welfare Vehicles attached to the corporation of Madras and 150 liters of diesel for Diesel Driven Vehicles and 240 liters of diesel to Audio Visual Vans attached to post pertum centres including those run by the Corporation of Madras.

(3) The expenditure on PGL & maintenance over and above the Government of India assistance be met from the state funds.

(4) Vehicles under the control of other departments in their respective Districts except vehicles of the departments of Police, Fire Services, Medical, Commercial Taxes, Judicial Vigilance and Anti-Corruption and district industrial centres without dislocating the normal work of the departments concerned to be used in connection with Family work and particularly in connection with organisation of sterilisation camps to achieve the target.

(5) To utilise the UNICEF Vehicles Outside the respective Block areas during the intensive Family work camps upto 31.3.88.

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(6) Permitted to draw not exceeding 300 liters of petrol per month (inclusive of the petrol already fixed) for each Vehicle of the other Departments drafted for work connected with the intensive Family work Camps.

(7) The Ceiling in matter of payment of T.A. to Government Servants be enhanced from 50% of basic pay to 75% of basic pay l.r.o. such of those staff as are engaged in intensive Family Welfare Campaign Conducted in the District subject to the condition that the drive period is restricted to four weeks in each particular Block at the discretion of the collector.

(8) The expenditure on T.A. to BDO & other staff of the Blocks engaged in the Family Welfare Campaign be initially met from the Gen. fund of the Panchayat Union concerned and then be got reimbursed from the concerned district Family Welfare maternity and child health officer's as the entire expenditure is reimbursable from the Government of India.

(9) Proper accounts shall be maintained to facilitate claims for reimbursement from the Government of India.

Government direct that the pension/Family Pension shall be paid on the last working day of the month to which it relates to.

FR-Pay-Fixation of pay of senior on par with the pay of Junior-Recommendation of 'One Man Committee' Under part 11- Grievances - orders issued.

As it is not possible to recover excess pension drawn by the retired Government servants due to erroneous fixation of pay as per existing pension notes, that in cases where fixation was of pay by Heads of Department was not ratified by the Government before retirement, Pension may be worked out provisionally based on the pay drawn prior to fixation and the pension revised after ratification by the Government.

PAYMENT OF FAMILY PENSION/D.C.R.G. - Clarification:

According to Rule 46(1)(a) of T.N. Pension Rules 1978, the gratuity is payable to Pension'(s) to whom the right to receive the gratuity is conferred by Government Servant by means of nomination under Rule 48. As such, when a valid nomination exists, the gratuity can be paid only to person(s) indicated in this valid nomination to whom the right to receive the gratuity has been conferred by Government servants. Other persons indicated in the succession certificate who are not valid nominees are not eligible for the gratuity and hence they could not be paid gratuity. However this is subject to the condition that there is no court direction to the Government to pay the amount specified in the decree/order as to whom and the rates at which it is directed to be paid and that the Government has not been impleaded in the suit.

In the case of Government servants having family, only the member of family as defined in Rule 45(5) of T.N. Pension Rules 1978 are eligible for D.C.R.G. Hence the non-members of family cannot be paid D.C.R.G.

The Divorce without any issued cannot be treated on unmarried Government Servant. As such consequent on the death of divorce with no issues, no one is eligible to receive Family Pension. But in the case of D.C.R.G. Other members of family defined in Rule 45(5) of T.N. Pension rules 1978 are eligible for DCRG in equal shares as per Rule 46(1)(b) of T.N. Pension Rules 1978. As such, Consequent on the death of the divorce with no issues, DCRG can be paid to other members of family defined in Rule 45(5) of T.N. Pension Rules 1978 in equal shares as indicated in Rule 46(1)(b) of T.N. Pension Rules 1978.

NOMINATION TO RECEIVE THE COMMUTED VALUE OF PENSION:

Government direct that

(i) An applicant shall make a nomination in the form annexed to this order along with the application for commutation of pension conferring on one or more persons the right to receive the commuted value of pension in case the applicant dies without receiving the commuted value on or after the date on which commutation becomes absolute.

(ii) If there is no such nomination, or if the nomination made does not subsist, the commuted value shall be paid to the family in the manner indicated in sub-rule (1) (b) of Rule 46 of T.N. Pension rules 1978.

(iii) If in any case the commuted value cannot be paid in the manner indicated in para (1) and (ii) above the same shall be paid to his heirs.

COMMUTATION OF PENSION - COMPULSORILY RETIRED FROM SERVICE -

ELIGIBILITY:

The Government clarify that Government servants who are compulsorily retired as a measure of punishment only should undergo medical examination even if they apply for commutation within one year from the date of issue of pension payment order and in other cases of compulsory retirement, they need not undergo medical examination, if they apply for commutation within one year from the date of issue of pension payment order.

DCRG - PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON DELAYED PAYMENT:

The Government clarify that for the payment of interest on the delayed payment of DCRG, no specific authorisation from the Accountant General is necessary. The Govt State that on the strength of the sanction accorded by the Department of secretariat interest may be worked out by the Department and a bill presented to the concerned treasury/pay and accounts office for the drawal and payment to the pensioners.

Allocation of leave salary and pension contribution between
Central and state Governments:-

The Government direct that the system of allocation of leave salary and pension between central and state Governments be dispensed with as specified below.

(a) Leave salary: The existing of allocation or sharing of the liability on account of leave salary contributions by central Government to state Government or vice-versa will be dispensed with. The liability for leave salary will be borne in full by the department from which the Government Servant proceeds on leave, whether it be his parent department or a borrowing department with whom he is on deputation.

(b) Pension: The liability for pension including gratuity will be borne in full by the central/State department to which the Government Servant permanently belongs at the time of retirement. No recovery of proportionate pension will be made from central / State Government under whom he had served.

(c) Contributory Provident Fund: The liability for Government contributions will be borne by the parent department of the central or state Government and no share of contributions will be record from any borrowing department.

The above provisions will be applicable to exchange of officers between two state Government also (with effect 1.4.87.

LEAVE RULES:

Grant of Long Leave to Government Servants:

The Government direct that

(1) No Government Servant (Permanent and approved Probationers) who has not completed Five years of service shall be granted leave of any kind for a continuous period exceeding six months at any one time except that it could be exceeded by U.EL on MC or study leave granted under the rules.

(2) No Government servant (Permanent and approved Probationers) who has completed five years of service shall be granted leave of any kind for a continuous period exceeding one year at any one time except that it could be exceeded by U.EL on MC or study leave granted under the rules.

(3) When a Government servant (permanent or approved probation) does not Resume duty after remaining on leave or absence for a continuous period of either six months or one year as the case may be, he may be removed from service, following the procedure laid down in Tamil Nadu Civil Services (Classification, control & appeal) Rules.

(4) There should be an interval of three years period between two spells of maximum leave so granted. In respect of

(5) In respect of the Non-permanent (Probationers and temporary) Government servants, the existing procedure under rule 23(a) (11) of T.N.L.R 1933 shall be followed except that here also there should be an interval of three years between the two spells of maximum leave so granted.

TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE:

L.T.C. clarifications issued:

The Government Servant who proposes to avail LTC has to undertake the journey only after obtaining orders sanctioning C.L. by the authority competent to permit LTC.

2. The Government servant who has been sanctioned CL on Monday coupling the Saturday & Sunday can commence the journey on Friday evening.

3. The Government servant can perform journey by 2 tier, A.C Super/ 1st Class A.C Chair-car by availing LTC. However, the claim shall be restricted to the class to which he is eligible or the actual fare paid, whichever is less.

4. The detailed claim for LTS cannot be admitted if it is prepared beyond the time limit prescribed in G.O.Ms.No: 407/F in/Dated 15.6.81.

The Government consider that sub rule 4(b) is advantageous to Office Assistants and have decided to delete the provisions under sub rule (c) under rule 4 mentioned above so as to enable the Office Assistants to avail HBA like any other Government servant under sub rule (b) of rule 4 of the HBA rules and to amend the rules to this effect.
