In the Government Order first and second read above, the World Bank assisted Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has implemented Non Communicable Disease Intervention Programme across Tamil Nadu with all its components of screening, preventing and treatment for Cardio Vascular Diseases, Diabetes Mellitus / Hyper Tension, Cervical and Breast Cancer. The task of concurrent evaluation and various surveys had been entrusted with National Institute of Epidemiology, Chennai on contract basis.

2. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has reported that in continuation of the concurrent evaluation and various survey reports being produced by the National Institute of Epidemiology and in order to keep the momentum of any given project activities at right gear, all the consolidated observations and findings come up during the project period are required to be welldocumented and published in scientific journals. With a view to accomplishing the above task, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is desirous of continuing collaborating with National Institute of Epidemiology, Chennai and draw the services of two Research Associates for a period of four months with monthly remuneration not exceeding Rs.40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only). These two placements

would cost Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project up to a total of Rs.3,20,000/- for the full course.

- 3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has further stated that the primary duty of Research Associates is to organize Non Communicable Disease data and facilitate writing of manuscript for publication. The sub-tasks include;-
 - Taking Non Communicable Disease data and transforming them into information that can be used by Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project and Department of Health and Family Welfare;

ii. Preparing analysis frameworks for analysis of the data;

iii. Cleaning / validating the data.

iv. Flagging data gaps and evolve ways and means to fill the gaps;

 Analyzing the data, preparation of reports and presentations for dissemination when required;

vi. Assessing the trends in health patterns given by different directorate and triangulate the data with other data sets wherever appropriate and available;

vii. Preparing manuscripts and articles by analyzing and interpreting the data under the supervision of Non Communicable Disease officials.

- 5. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project has, therefore, requested to permit him to utilize the expertise of National Institute of Epidemiology and also to permit him to hire two Research Associates.
- 6. The Government, after careful examination permit the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project to utilize the expertise of National Institute of Epidemiology and also to hire two Research Associates for a period of four months with monthly remuneration not exceeding Rs.40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only) with a total cost of Rs.3,20,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh and Twenty Thousand only) for the full course.
