### ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Director of Municipal Administration has stated that Administrative Sanction for developing centralized web based application software, procurement of additional hardware & software with Facility Management service and for providing TNSWAN connectivity at an estimated cost of Rs. 14.21 crore. The Director of Municipal Administration has also stated that the Government of India has approved the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) on May 18, 2006 comprising of Mission Mode Projects (MMPs) at the Central and State level. The vision of the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) is to make all Government services accessible to the common man, through common service delivery outlets and to ensure efficiency, transparency and reliability of such services at affordable costs to realise the basic needs of the common man. The Government of India has also formulated the vision, approach, strategy, key components and implementation framework of the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP). The existing/ongoing projects in the Municipal Mission Mode Project category, being implemented by various Central Ministries/State departments should be suitably augmented to align them with the objectives of National e-Governance Plan (NeGP). The vision for the National Mission Mode Project for e-Governance in Municipalities is to leverage the ICT opportunities for sustained improvement in efficiency and effectiveness of delivery of municipal services to the citizens. The Director of Municipal Administration has stated that the various application modules like Birth & Death, Property Tax, Water Charges, Non Tax, Professional Tax, FAS, Building Plan, Pay Roll etc. have been implemented in ULBs and the same system is being implemented in Grade-III Municipalities as well. They need to be augmented to align themselves with the objectives of NeGP. A proposal for the e-governance enhancement in ULBs for implementation during the remaining period of

TNUDP-III was presented to the World Bank Mid Term Mission team during its visit to Chennai between July 14<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> 2008 and the proposal has also been accepted by the Mission team. The proposal consists of the following three components.

- a) Centralized Web based Application Software for all ULBs
- b) Hardware & Software Requirements with Facility Management services at Head quarters covering all ULBs
- c) Connectivity expansion using TNSWAN

2. The Director of Municipal Administration has stated that the total expenditure involved in the above proposals will be as follows.

- a) developing centralized web based software for all ULBs at an estimated cost of **Rs. 3.24 crore**
- b) for procuring Hardware and Software with Facility management service at an estimated cost of **Rs. 7.08 crore**
- c) to provide the TNSWAN connectivity to all ULBs at an estimated cost of **Rs. 3.89 crore**

The Total estimated cost for all the above three proposals will be Rs. 14.21 crore. These proposals have been approved by the State Level Project Sanctioning Committee (SLPSC) in its 7<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17.11.2009 and have been recommended to the Government for according Administrative Sanction.

3. The Director of Municipal Administration has requested the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for the implementation of the above three Projects mentioned in para 2 above approved by the SLPSC in its 7<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 17/11/2009 at an estimated cost of Rs. 14.21 crore. This expenditure will be met from the ICT component of TNUDP-III.

4. The Government have carefully examined the recommendation of Seventh State Level Project Sanctioning Committee in its meeting held on 17.11.2009 in Agenda No.10. and hereby accord administrative approval for developing centralized web based application software, procurement of additional hardware & Software with Facility Management service and for providing TNSWAN connectivity at an estimated cost of Rs.14.21 crore.
