ORDER:

In the G.O.s first and second read above, first and second installments of Government of India and Government of Tamil Nadu share for implementation of BSUP scheme in Chennai Corporation phase – I at Rs. 2974.47 lakhs each has been released.

2. In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Municipal Administration has stated that in the Government of India letter third read above the Government of India being 25% of its share as III installment has sanctioned and released a sum of Rs. 1267.76 lakh to Chennai Corporation.

3. The Director of Municipal Administration has therefore requested the Government to release the amount of Rs. 1267.76 lakh sanctioned and released by the Government of India as 3rd installment and corresponding State share of Rs. 1706.71 lakh totaling to Rs. 2974.47 lakhs to the Directorate of Municipal Administration for implementation of BSUP scheme in Chennai Corporation phase – I as detailed below:-
