ORDER:

1. In the letter second read above the Commissioner of Municipal Administration has stated that in the G.O.Ms.No.16, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department, dated 08.02.2006. Government have nominated the Commissioner of Municipal Administration as Nodal Agency for two schemes namely submission of Basic Services for the Urban Poor under the JNNURM and for IHSDP. The Nodal Agency shall be responsible among other things for the management of grants received from Government of India and Government of Tamil Nadu.

2. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration has now stated in the letter third read above that as the Government of India have sanctioned some additional amount under IHSDP, the following proposal is sent to Government to release the state share of Rs.23.00 crores as detailed below against Government of India share of Rs.112.55 crores.

3. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration has informed that their Commissionerate have submitted 297 proposals under integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme for an amount of Rs.772.00 crores to Government of India through HUDCO for approval. Out of these Government of India have sanctioned 22 proposals for Rs.146.05 crores. The remaining 275 proposals for Rs.625.95 are under scrutiny with Government of India and it is expected that some more proposals will be sanctioned shortly. The criteria for release of funds as per IHSDP guidelines – para No.6.2 is State share has to be deposited in a separate account to become eligible for the Central grant. 50% of the Central grant will be released to the State Nodal Agency after verification of the state share, and on signing the tripartite Memorandum of Agreement Second Instalment will be released based on the progress.

4. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration has therefore requested that the entire budget provision of Rs.40.00 crores for the year 2006-2007 may be released in advance so as to get financial assistance from Government of India periodically in time for implementing the Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme.

5. The Government, after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Municipal Administration sanction and release a sum of Rs.40.00 crores being the entire Budget provision for the IHSDP scheme for the year 2006-2007.

6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited in the following head of account.

“2217 Urban Development – 04 Slum Area Improvement – 192. Assistant to Municipalities / Municipal Councils Schemes in Tenth Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JB. Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme – 09. Grants in aid -02. Grants for capital Expenditure (D.P.Code 2217 04 192 JB 0925.”

7. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above for the above scheme to the Urban Local Bodies.
