KfW assisted Sustainable Municipal Infrastructure Financing – Tamil Nadu (SMIF – TN) Program –Providing Storm Water Drains for Tiruppur Corporation at an estimated cost of Rs.40.00 crores – Administrative Sanction – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, Government accorded administrative sanction for implementation of KfW assisted Sustainable Municipal Infrastructure Financing – Tamil Nadu (SMIF-TN) Program with a total project cost of Euro 77 million (equivalent to about Rs.500 crores), which investment component to Urban Local Bodies Euro 65 million (equivalent to about Rs.422 Crores). The Government have also constituted an Empowered Committee for sanctioning, finalizing the means of finance including the quantum of capital grants and according administrative sanction for the sub-projects to be funded under the KfW assisted Sustainable Municipal Infrastructure Financing – Tamil Nadu (SMIF- TN) Program.

2. The Director of Municipal Administration in his letter third read above, has sent proposal for providing Storm Water Drains system in Tiruppur Corporation.. The approximate cost of the project is Rs.40.00 crores and the implementation period is 12 months:-

3. The Tiruppur Corporation has also resolved to provide storm water drains at an estimated cost of Rs.40.00 Crores.

4. The above proposal was placed before the Empowered Committee constituted in the G.O first read above for consideration on 11.11.2008 by the TNUIFSL. The Committee resolved to (i) approve the proposal and accord administrative sanction for implementation of Storm Water Drains in Tiruppur Corporation at an estimated project cost of Rs. 40 crores, (ii) sanction of Rs. 10 crores as capital grant under KfW Grant Fund I and (iii) approve the following means of finance:
