



Abstract

KfW assisted Sustainable Municipal Infrastructure Financing – Tamil Nadu (SMIF – TN) Program – Implementation of water supply improvement scheme to Tirunelveli Corporation at an estimated cost of Rs.22.22 crores – Administrative Sanction – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, Government accorded administrative sanction for implementation of KfW assisted Sustainable Municipal Infrastructure Financing – Tamil Nadu (SMIF-TN) Program with a total project cost of Euro 77 million (equivalent to about Rs.500 crores), which investment component to Urban Local Bodies in Euro 65 million (equivalent to about Rs.422 Crores). The Government have also constituted an Empowered Committee for sanctioning, finalizing the means of finance including the quantum of capital grants and according administrative sanction for the sub-projects to be funded under the KfW assisted Sustainable Municipal Infrastructure Financing – Tamil Nadu (SMIF- TN) Program.

2. The Director of Municipal Administration in his letter third read above, has sent proposal for implementation of water supply improvement scheme to Tirunelveli Corporation. At present the corporation is supplying water at the prescribed norm of 135 lpcd, except in 8 wards where the supply is about 50 to 65 lpcd. The scheme is designed for a capacity of about 6.72 mld and with this additional capacity, the corporation can

supply water at the prescribed norm of 135 lpcd for all the wards. The approximate cost of the project is Rs.22.22 crores with the following funding pattern:-

3. The Tirunelveli Corporation Council has also resolved to providing water supply improvement scheme at an estimated cost of Rs.22.22 crores.

4. The above proposal was placed before the Empowered Committee constituted in the G.O first read above for consideration on 11.11.2008 by the TNUIFSL. The Committee resolved to (i) approve the proposal and accord administrative sanction for implementation of Water Supply Improvement Scheme for Tirunelveli Corporation at an estimated project cost of Rs. 22.22 crores and at an estimated annual maintenance cost of Rs. 57.50 lakhs, (ii) sanction Rs. 6.66 crores as capital grant under KfW Grant Fund I and (iii) approve the following means of finance:-

Based on the approval of the Empowered Committee, the Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Municipal Administration and hereby accord administrative sanction for implementation of water supply improvement scheme to Tirunelveli Corporation at an estimated cost of Rs.22.22 crores and Rs.57.50 lakhs

to maintain annually as per the pattern of funding outlined in para 4 above

6. Any escalation in project cost and O & M shall have to be borne by the Corporation only.
