Order:

The Director of Municipal administration in his letter read above has informed that the remote controlling of valves monitoring through computers known as Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition System (SCADA) is the latest technique adopted in major water supply schemes by Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board and Chennai Metro Water Supply & Sewage Board and that will facilitate easy operation of valves in Head works at remote areas and proper monitoring of water supply distribution.

2. He has also stated that the system had been introduced and under implementation in the Madurai and Tirunelveli City Municipal Corporations which are completed in the previous year 2009-10 and now, it has been proposed to provide that system to the Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation for the Pillur Water Supply Scheme Phase-II which is being implemented under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission.

3. He has further requested to sanction full grant of Rs.4.00 crores for this project sought for under the Part –II Scheme for the year 2010-11 .

4. The Government, after careful examination, accept the proposal and sanction a sum of Rs.4.00 Crores (Rupees four Crores only) for Providing Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition System for Pillur Water Supply Scheme for Coimbatore Corporation under Part II Scheme for the year 2010-2011.

5. The amount sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-
