ORDER

In the Government Order first read above, the Government appointed Chief Electrical Inspector to Government to decide upon the Compensation amount to be paid by the Madurai Corporation to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board. In the Government Order second read above, the Government directed that all properties, belonging to Madurai Corporation Electrical undertaking including fixed assets, cash, securities, investments, documents and the like and all its rights, liabilities and obligations as on the vesting date including the rights, liabilities and obligation of the licensee under any agreement to supply Electricity entered into before the vesting date which devolve on the Government on the date of vesting under Tamil Nadu Electricity Supply undertaking (Acquisition) Act, 1954 (Tamil Nadu XXIX of 1954) be transferred to shall be deemed to have been to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board and vested in the Board with effect on and from the 30th April 1995. The Government also direct that all the staff of the licensee undertaking immediately before the vesting date namely the 30th April 1995, be transferred and shall be deemed to have been transferred to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board with effect on and from such vesting date.

2) The Commissioner, Madurai Corporation in his letter third read above has stated that the net compensation arrived by the Chief Electrical Inspector to Government is not agreeable by Madurai Corporation and hence they had already requested the Joint Commissioner, Commissionerate of Municipal Administration Chennai to form a new committee to revise the gross compensation.

3) The Commissioner of Municipal Administration in his letter fifth read above has proposed to form a new committee consisting of the following members under the Chairmanship of Commissioner of Municipal Administration to find a solution to the long pending dispute of finalization of net compensation in respect of Madurai, Coimbatore Corporations and Thanjavur, Karur, Pollachi Municipalities :

5) Government have examined the proposal of Commissioner of Municipal Administration and the Chairman, Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Chennai and have decided to constitute a new Committee under the Chairmanship of Director of Municipal Administration, to find a solution for finalizing the compensation amount and settlement of current consumption arrears in respect of Madurai, Coimbatore Corporations and Thanjavur, Karur, Pollachi Municipalities. Accordingly a Committee shall be constituted with the following composition:-
