ORDER:

The Government of India's contribution towards the purchase of buses for Chennai, Coimbatore and Madurai cities under JnNURM Scheme is as follows :

2. The Government of India's share Rs.144.37 crores mentioned at Col (4) above has to be released in two installments. Accordingly, In the G.O. 1st and 2nd read above a sum of Rs.8581.80 lakhs has been released as first installment of Government of India's assistance under the JnNURM Scheme. The above funds have been deposited in the Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd., PD Account (No. 11 G.O. 3099750 BQ) which is in the name of "Tamil Nadu Urban Infrastructure and Renewal Fund".

3. The formal administrative sanction for the purchase of 1600 buses under JnNURM Scheme with the aid of Government of India has been issued in the G.O. 3rd read above. The Bills relating to all transactions towards procurement of buses under the above scheme are to be settled by the Transport Development Finance Corporation Ltd. Hence, the amount now deposited in the Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd., PD Account is to be released to the Transport Development Finance Corporation Ltd.,

4. Accordingly, the Government direct that the sum of Rs.8581.80 lakhs which has been deposited in the Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd., PD Account in pursuance of the G.Os. first and second read above, be released to the Transport Development Finance Corporation Ltd., to facilitate them to settle the bus procurement bills.
