**ORDER :**

In the memo first read above, charges were framed against Thiru P.Jayapaul, formerly Chief Engineer (now retired) under Regulation 10 (1) of Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board Employees (Discipline and Appeal) Regulations,1978 for the following lapse relating to the work of Second Chennai Project and allied works implemented by the Board during the year 1996-2001:

- 1) "He has failed to super-check the works under LD&R works Phase IV and V as per the as per the orders of the M.D. and thus failed to ensure the quality execution of work as per technical specifications.
- 2) He has recommended alternative filling materials instead of sea sand in violation of contract conditions without obtaining the approval of the Board and without consent from the Corporation of Chennai.

3) He has countersigned the bills for the above works as Exe. Engineer instead of by Superintending Engineer.

His above act amounts to neglect of work and misconduct under Regulation 6(20) & 6(38) of CMWSS Board Employees (Discipline and Appeal) Regulations, 1978.

6(20) – Any breach of any rule”.

2. In the reference second read above, Thiru P.Jayapaul, formerly Chief Engineer, Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board has submitted his explanation. The Board of Directors of Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board has considered the recommendations of the Personnel Committee which examined the lapses and the explanation of the delinquent officer, held the charges as not proved and recommended to drop the charges and has decided to drop further action against Thiru P.Jayapaul, formerly Chief Engineer (Retired) vide resolution third read above.

3. The Government have examined the views of the Board carefully and independently along with the relevant original records of the case and have decided to accept the same. They accordingly direct that the charges against Thiru P.Jayapaul, formerly Chief Engineer (Retired), Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board be dropped.
